Students will learn advanced grooming techniques to meet AKC Standards.

Learn Valuable Industry Skills!

Students will learn to perform animal grooming duties such as washing and brushing animals. Students will have basic understanding of clipping coats, cutting nails, and cleaning ears. They will learn how to collect and record animal information such as weight, size, physical condition, treatments received.

Students will learn strategies in working with various breeds of cats and dogs, as well as animals with behavioral problems.

Students will learn safety concerns and the importance of proper sanitation, as well as recognizing signs of illness, injury, parasite-infestation.

Students will train in aspects of serving the public such as responding to questions from clients, providing information about animals (behavior, nutrition, health-concerns) and the facility, answering telephones and general customer

service.
