STAFF REPORTS

Superintendent Christine Hoffman gave a detailed presentation of the 2010/2011 Annual Report to the Board. Superintendent Hoffman discussed SoCal ROC's progress in the areas reflective of SoCal ROC's Board Goals and "Targets for Success".
