Superintendent Hoffman presented the 2011-2012 Annual Report to the Board. Superintendent Hoffman addressed the seven areas of the Board Goals and "Targets of Success": Curriculum and Instruction, Staff Development, Finance and Business, Articulation, Articulation - Satellite, Recognition, and Facilities. Priorities for 2012/2013 were reviewed with a focus on:



- Improved student achievement; specifically, increasing the number of students who qualify for a Certificate of Competency in their CTE area of study.
- Improvement of facilities, technology, and equipment for various CTE programs offered at the Center to enhance the overall experience and preparation of students.
- Budget strategies that ensure an adequate reserve for cash-flow amid possible continuation of declining state revenues.
- Heightened awareness of Legislators regarding CTE and the role that SoCal ROC plays in career preparation, advanced studies, and job procurement. Additionally, support and play an active role in the authoring and passage of legislation that promotes continued CTE opportunities in California.
- Continue to identify and increase the number of students taking State/National Exams and passing exams.
- Continue to identify and secure viable Advisory Committee Members for all Sectors.
- Develop OJT experiences for top students in Engineering and Art /Design
- Increase the number of programs and students to be "highlighted" and "recognized" at Board meetings.
